

Chandler Police Department Chief's Monthly Report January 2012

The police monthly report is, as you will see, dropping in numbers. The end of the year has passed and the New Year has begun with a little less police action. Some numbers are down and in a sense that is a good thing.

The police monthly report is as follows:

- **3 Motor vehicle accidents were reported, and all were minor.**
- **2** Agency assist were responded to. 1 assisting DPS on MVA outside the city, the other was domestic disturbance with a fight reported in progress in Brownsboro.
- **1 Assault report was filed that involved air rifles and rocks being exchanged between some under age kids.**
- **1** Burglary of a vehicle was reported. The case is still open.
- **3 Reports of "Child Endangerment" where children were left unattended in a motor vehicle. The parents were dealt with at the scene.**
- **10** Alarm calls were responded to and are as follows: 3 residential, 6 businesses, and 1 church. All were false alarms.
- **3 City code violations. Two were fireworks, and one was cease and desist work order.**
- **6** Disturbances were responded to and are as follows: 2 verbals, 1 barking dog, 2 loud music, and 1 domestic.
- **1 Forgery report was made n a forgery of a check. A warrant has been issued for the suspect.**
- **1** Illegal Dumping reported in a dumpster by private residential person(s). The situation was taken care of by the officer taking the report.
- **5 Animal control reports were made and are as follows: 2 reports of a wild EMU (that was captured, by the "Reeves Rescue Rangers"), 1 loose dog, 1 report of sick raccoon, and the report of a mouse in a residence!**
- **1** Case was worked on a minor in possession of tobacco. Citation was issued for the offense.
- **13 On site arrest were made by the officers on duty. They are as follows: 5**

DWLI, 2 possession of controlled substance, 4 traffic offenses, 1 DWI, and 1 possession of marijuana. All arrested and awaiting court.

- **8** Public Service calls made by the officers on duty. They are, 3 Courtesy transports, 3 motorist stranded, and 2 funeral escorts.
- **1 Report made of tree debris blocking the traffic lanes on a city street. The officer on duty removed the debris.**
- **4** Reports of Suspicious activity reported and is as follows: 2 suspicious vehicles, and 2 suspicious persons. Officers responded accordingly.
- **1 Report of the theft of a trailer was reported and is still an open case.**
- **1** Residence was found unsecured by a homeowner when she returned home and found garage door open and called the officer on duty to check the residence. Everything was found to be ok.
- **7 Outstanding warrants were served on persons stopped by officers on traffic stops. All were arrested and placed in the County jail.**
- **13** Reports were responded to in the miscellaneous category and are as follows: 5 welfare concern reports, 5 reckless drivers, 2 abandoned vehicles, and 1 possession of drug paraphernalia.
