Chief's Monthly Report

July 2012

July monthly crimes and incident report is as follows:

- **8 Reportable motor vehicle accidents reports worked and filed. 4 were major damage accidents with non-life threatening injuries. 4 were minor in nature with no injuries.**
- 9 Assist other agency calls responded to and are as follows: 7 assist EMS within the city, 1 assist CVFD within the city, and 1 assist HCSO which was an elderly man with Alzheimer's that had walked into the city from Forest Grove area.
- **4 Burglary reports were taken. They are as follows: 1 burglary of a business, 1 burglary of a residence and 2 burglaries of vehicles. All cases are under investigation with a person(s) of interest being questioned.**
- 15 Burglar alarm calls were responded to as follows: 12 business alarms (! Of which was an actual burglary) and 3 residential alarms.
- **2 Reports of criminal mischief reported and investigated. 1 was mail box being damaged, and 1 vehicle rear glass shot out by possible pellet or BB gun.**
- 1 Report of a loose dog running through a neighborhood. The owner was contacted and the dog was taken care of.
- **4 Reports of disturbances were responded to and are as follows: 2 verbal, 1 domestic, and 1 intoxicated person. All were responded to and appropriate action taken.**
- 3 Reports of Fraud were made by officers. 2 were credit card fraud and 1 check fraud. Cases under investigation.
- **1 Report of a lost cell phone was reported and report made.**
- 7 Reports of loose animals were responded to and appropriate action taken. They are as follows: 1 wild animal in a residential yard (not sick or injured), 1 loose livestock, and 5 stray dogs.
- **1 Charge of possession of tobacco products by minor was filed. Minor will be summoned to municipal court.**
- 3 On site arrest were made and are as follows: 1 fictitious registration sticker, 1 public intoxication, and 1 DWI.
- **1 Prowler report was responded to and no person or prowler was located.**
- 6 Public Service calls were logged and responded to. 3 assist stranded motorist, 1 funeral escort, and 2 assist citizens at their residents.
- **8 Road hazards were responded to and taken care of by the officer on duty. 1 deep in road way removed, 5 vehicles were blocking the roadways and removed, and 2 debris dropped from a vehicle were removed from the roadway.**

- **2 Suspicious person calls were responded to and appropriate action was taken by the responding officer.**
- 3 Theft reports were taken and are under investigation. (Same person(s) of interest as the burglaries) 2 were theft of personal property \$500.00 or more but less than \$1,500.00, and 1 theft of property \$50.00 or more but less than \$500.00.
- **1 Church was found unsecured by officer on duty. Key holder was called and secured the building.**
- 7 Warrants were served by officers on duty.
- 22 Miscellaneous Calls were responded to and are as follows: 1 damage to private property, 1 drug information received, 2 property releases, 1 abandoned vehicle, 1 possession of drug paraphernalia, 5 false calls, 2 harassments, 2 reckless drivers, 2 animal bites, 5 civil cases. All calls were responded to and appropriate action was taken by the responding officer.
