Chief's Report

Sept. 2012

Crimes and Incidents reports for the month of September 2012 is as follows:

- **11 Motor vehicle accidents reported. 9 Minor accidents with no injuries, 2 accidents with injuries; non life threatening.**
- 9 Agency assist reports. 2 HCSO, 5 EMS, 1 CVFD, and 1 assist in the city; attempt to locate.
- **4 Burglary reports made. 1 building, 1 habitation, 1 vehicle, 1 attempted burglary. All cases under investigation.**
- 7 Alarm calls responded to. 5 business, 2 fire alarms at Chandler school. All false.
- **3 Criminal Trespass calls.**
- 1 Criminal mischief to a business.
- **2 City code violations for garage sale signs.**
- 3 Disturbance calls responded to. 2 verbal, 1 domestic.
- **8 Forgery / Fraud / Credit card reports. 1 attempted fraud, 4 credit card, 3 check forgery. All cases under investigation where there is sufficient evidence.**
- 2 Reports of lost or found property. 1 lost dog later found and returned.
- **7 Animal control calls. 4 loose livestock, 3 loose dogs. Most of the loose livestock calls are from Tindell cattle going through a fence. Mr. Tindell refuses to mend the fence properly and continues to state that it is the cities fault for removing his old fence during the Martin St. construction.**
- 5 On site arrest made. 3 Possession of controlled substance, 2 public intoxication
- **15 Public service calls made. 14 stranded motorist, and 1 funeral escort.**
- 7 calls of suspicious category. 2 suspicious activity, 1 odor of possible natural gas, 3 suspicious vehicles, 1 suspicious person. All calls responded to and appropriate action taken by the responding officer.
- **4 Theft reports made. 1 class "C" theft, 1 theft of property valued \$50.00 or more less than \$500.00, and 2 theft of property valued \$500.00 less than \$1,500.00. All Cases under investigation where there is sufficient evidence.**
- 1 Traffic control around a gas main break
- **7 Warrants served by on duty officer.**
- 34 Criminal and non criminal miscellaneous calls as follows: 4 welfare concern, 7 reckless driving, 10 civil, 3 poss. of drug paraphernalia, 1 tampering with physical evidence, 1 recover lost dog, 2 abandoned vehicles, 1 disorderly conduct, 1 release of stolen property, 1 harassment, 1 fleeing police, 1 animal bite, and 1 mental.
