Chief's Monthly Report

Crimes and Incidents

March 2013

The March crimes and incidents report is as follows:

- **6 Accident reports made and filed. All were minor with no life threatening injuries.**
- 11 Agency assist calls reported as follows: SCSO – 1, CVFD-1, DPS-1, EMS-5, TPD-1 and HCSO-2
- **1 Residential burglary reported. Case is under investigation.**
- 10 Alarm calls responded to. 6 business, 4 residential
- **2 Criminal trespass reports made. Subjects involved left the area without incident.**
- 54 Code violations reported. 40 house number violations, 2 illegal posted signs, 8 garage sale signs, 2 trash container violations, 1 fence violation, 1 illegal use of property
- **7 Disturbance calls responded to as follows: 5 verbal, 1 barking dog, 1 domestic**
- 4 Forgery / Fraud reports filed. 2 check forgeries, 2 credit card abuse
- **1 Found property; lost mail found and returned to the rightful owner.**
- 7 Animal control calls reported and filed. 5 stray dog reports, 2 loose livestock
- **3 On site arrest made by officers on duty. 2 DWLI's, 1 PI**
- 8 Public service calls made by officers on duty. 3 funeral escorts, 5 assist stranded motorist
- **1 Debris found as traffic hazard and removed by officer on duty.**
- 12 Calls of suspicious nature responded to as follows: 6 suspicious persons, 3 activity, 1 noise, 1 odor, 1 smoke.
- **1 Theft of ID reported. Case under investigation**
- 1 Building found unsecured by the officer on duty. Owner notified and building was secured.
- **5 Outstanding warrants served by officer on duty.**
- 42 Miscellaneous criminal and non criminal calls responded to as follows: 6 welfare concerns, 6 reckless drivers, 1 Attempt to locate, 1 harassment, 6 traffic stops which ended out of city limits, 1 inquest, 2 disorderly conducts, 3 civil, 1 report of person fishing and reported a stray bullet from the firing range, 4 possession of drug paraphernalia, 3 illegally parked vehicles, 2 reckless damage to private or public property, 3 prowlers, 1 report of sex offender violating order, 1 reposed vehicle and 1 person reported drunk in public. All calls were responded to by the officer on duty and appropriate action or report made or filed.
