Crimes and Incidents Report

August 2012

Crimes and Incidents for the month of August 2012 are as follows:

- **4 Reportable motor vehicle accidents. All minor in nature with no serious injuries.**
- 15 Assist other agencies reported. 10 Assist EMS inside the city limits, 2 assist DPS outside city, 3 assist HCSO outside the city.
- **2 Burglaries reported. 1 residential and one storage building. Storage building property located in Athens Auction. Recovered partial property. Suspect possibly identified.**
- 8 Burglar alarm reports reported. All false, all business alarms.
- **3 Criminal trespass reports made. Persons warned away from the area, all complied.**
- 1 Criminal mischief report made which was a residence “wrapped” with toilet paper. Kids came and cleaned up.
- **20 City Code violation reports made. 1 barking dog, 16 improperly placed garage signs, 1 improperly placed bandit sign, 2 loose dogs, 1 violation of person selling an animal, brought to the officers attention by improperly placed signage.**
- 5 Reports made of disturbances and are as follows: 3 verbal, 1 loud music, 1 loud noise. All parties complied without further action.
- **4 Reports made on lost or found property. 1 found purse, 1 found wallet, 1 lost wallet, (not same as found one), 1 recovery of stolen property.**
- 1 Report made on illegal dumping in a commercial dumpster. Violator cleaned up trash, no further action.
- **6 Reported loose livestock or animal complaints. 5 Loose livestock, 1 reported aggressive dog. Owners of animals complied with taking care of complaints.**
- 3 On site arrest made by the officer’s on duty. 1 P.I., 1 possession of drugs, 1 possession of marijuana.
- **9 Public service calls responded to. 1 funeral escort, 7 assist stranded motorist, 1 courtesy transport.**
- 2 Reports on road hazards removed by the officer on duty. 1 partial tree in roadway, 1 debris fallen from a truck.
- **6 Calls responded to as follows, considered suspicious in nature by caller. 1 suspicious vehicle, 2 suspicious persons, 3 suspicious activity, 1 suspicious odor. All calls checked out by the responding officer and appropriate action taken.**
- 2 Theft reports made. Both were theft of property of values \$50.00 or more less than \$500.00. Cases under investigation.
- **1 Report of officer having to do traffic control.**
- 9 Outstanding warrants were served by officers on duty.
- **30 Calls that fall under the miscellaneous category are as follows: 5 Civil calls, 12 Reckless drivers, 1 terroristic threat, 1 child locked themselves in a vehicle, 3 welfare concerns, 1 abandoned animal, 1 report of vehicle blocking view on roadway, 2 abandoned vehicles, 1 animal cruelty, 1 traffic complaint, 1 utility problem, and 1 reckless damage to private property. All calls were responded to and the responding officer took appropriate action.**
