**Police Report for the month of January 2013 is as follows:**

- **5 Accidents reported, all minor no injury. One of the 5 was in a parking lot.**

- **1 Domestic assault reported, no charges filed. Victim signed non prosecution form.**
- 3 Residential burglary reports made. All cases open and under investigation.

- 5 Criminal trespass calls made. All being people entering private property to fish. All were notified and warned.

At residence, 3 sign ordinance violations, 3 junk vehicles, 2 burning violations, 3 garage sale sign violations, 1 unfinished building, 1 possible illegal burning, 2 stray dogs, 2 piled rubbish.
