New Residential Recycling & Trash Service (begins 10/4/22)

Trash Pick-up twice per week Tuesday & Friday Beginning October 4th

- One 95-gallon trash cart will be delivered to residential and commercial hand-collect addresses prior to October 1, 2022.
- Bulk pickup will be collected twice per month. Bulk must be called in and scheduled to be picked up.
- All trash must be bagged and placed inside the cart. This helps keep the city clean and litter-free by preventing trash from blowing around before and during service. Carts must be placed at the curb no later than 7 a.m. on your service day or the night before.
- Additional trash carts will be available for order after October 1, 2022, for an additional monthly charge. Call Republic Services at **903.986.5324** for more information.
- Carts must be at least 3' away (for safety) from any objects, including mailboxes, parked cars, meters, fire hydrants, utility poles and other carts. *Please note that personal containers may not be used. Republic Services® is not responsible for damage to personal trash containers.*
- Broken and/or damaged carts will be replaced or repaired by Republic Services. Personal carts will not.
- Stolen carts will be replaced by Republic Services after the resident files a police report.
- Carts are numbered and are the property of Republic Services and must remain at the designated address.
- Assistance for the disabled: Assistance will be provided to those households that have no able-bodied persons to transport the cart to the curb and back. Please call Republic Services at **903.986.5324** or the City of Chandler at **903.849.6853** to set up this service. A note from a physician may be required.
- Bulk items: Republic Services will provide bulk item curbside collection twice a month for all areas of the city, and will include up to two bulk items (sofas, mattresses, washing machines, old water heaters, etc.). Please call **903.986.5324** to schedule a pickup. Please leave your name, address, phone number and type of items to be removed.
- Bulk Pickup: Leaves should be dry and securely bagged (20-bag limit per pickup day). Bundles should be securely tied and weigh no more than 50 lbs. Please call **903.986.5324** for more information.
- Residential customers may use their current City of Chandler water bill and ID for a free landfill pass each month for 3 cubic yards at Greenwood Farms Landfill located at 12920 FM 2767, Tyler.
- *Important Note: Republic Services delays trash pickup on three holidays only: Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Year's Day. If the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, your pickup day will be as usual, Tuesday and Friday.*

The recycling cart is located at the City of Chandler maintenance barn. Only recyclable items go into the cart (see back page). Please keep cart area neat and clean.
