## **ENSURING OUR SUSTAINABILITY**

- Took over operation of County Library and transitioned to State Accredited City Library
- Began major capital improvement project at Wastewater Treatment Plant
- Acquired bucket truck for the city's many maintenance needs
- Renegotiated city's electric power contract
- Began drilling Chandler's 5<sup>th</sup> water well

- Repaired sewer line and widened 4<sup>th</sup> street at Hwy 31
- Improved city's computer back up and other technology improvements
- Re-lamped baseball fields at Winchester Park
- Acquired field lighting from Brownsboro High School for future ball field
- Equipped police cars with computers to improve communication and safety
- Rebuilt water well #2's booster pumps and replaced pump in well #4
- Expanded the Chlorination retention system at well #1 to meet new state guidelines
- Added 6" water supply line on West Main
- Smoke tested all city sewer lines and repaired infiltration faults
- Began mulching program to provide free mulch to residents and for city use
- New rotors installed at waste water treatment plant to provide improved oxygenation
- Completed City/County road project on southern portion of Martin Street
- Removed 4 substandard houses from the city
