

City of Chandler Common Code Violations

High Grass and Weeds

Weeds and grass over 12 inches in height are a violation. Property owners and tenants are responsible for keeping their lawns mowed to the edge of the roadway.

Junked Vehicles

Any vehicle in public view that is inoperable for 30 days, wrecked, dismantled and not registered or licensed is considered a junk vehicle.

Junk, Trash and Debris

Properties should be kept free of unsightly buildup of litter, garbage, and/or junk which is likely to become unsanitary, offensive or likely to create disease.

Substandard Structures

Any residence, building or structure which becomes dilapidated, deteriorated, or damaged in condition due to lack of maintenance is determined to be a fire hazard.

Illegal Dumping

Examples include unauthorized use of a dumpster; discarding trash and debris on another's property; or dumping left over construction materials on private or public properties.

Texas Health & Safety Code Chapter 341 Minimum Standards of Sanitation and Health Protection Measures; Texas Health & Safety Code Chapter 365; Texas Litter Abatement Act; and Texas Water Code Chapter 7 Enforcement.



Commercial Vehicles

A truck tractor, road tractor, semitrailer, bus, truck or trailer or any other commercial vehicle with a related carrying capacity of 2 tons or more may not be parked in a residential area nor may be parked in a public street.
